Over the Top Corn is a proprietary formulation of auxiliary nutrients (major and micronutrients), designed for foliar application on corn, sorghum and other grains. The nutrient base is fortified with natural diterpenes, extracts of ascophyllum nodosum, natural fermentation compounds and enzymes.

Over the Top Corn boosted yields by 4.5 Bu./A. during its inagural year of use here at Beck's, which translates to a return on investment of \$7.92/A. Growing conditions were exceptional this summer, so many products did little to boost yields any further. Over the Top Corn, however, did well and it will be interesting to see how this product performs in a tougher growing year. We look forward to testing this product again in the future.
